PROSTHETICS

Prosthetic and Orthotic appliances are items that are medically necessary to:

RESTORE bodily functions essential to activities of daily living

PREVENT significant physical disability or serious deterioration health

ALLEVIATE severe pain.

Prostheses, commonly known as artificial limbs, must be of high quality, both technically and aesthetically to be truly beneficial. In addition, developing a lasting relationship between prosthetic practitioner and patient is of utmost importance to best serve long-term patient needs.

Orthoses are force systems, commonly known as braces that act on segments of the body (e.g. the head, neck, shoulders, arms, hand, spine, hip, legs, ankles and feet). An orthosis may be used for support, correction of a deformity, or for stabilization of a joint or limb. An orthosis can be either off-shelf or custom molded for a tailor made fit.



There are multiple types of prosthesis for amputations.
